

Our Programs

High School Diploma Program

Students who complete Ontario High School courses, will achieve Ontario Secondary School Diploma (OSSD), and can also apply to any Canadian and/or International Universities

who can apply ?

Students from middle schools or current course takers for Grades 9, 10, 11 and 12 (or current course takers in the International Baccalaureate Diploma Program (IB), O-level)

University Preparation-Fast Track Program

UPC is a program for international students who have a high school diploma from their home country. Students should choose 6 credit courses for their university application based on their career plans. This aims to help students enhance their comprehensive academic ability and English skills, and make sufficient preparation for entering university in a short time (around 6 month)

Who can apply ?

Students who have graduated from high school and have already obtained a high school diploma (or graduates from the International Baccalaureate Diploma Program(IB), O-level)

ESL program includes five levels: ESLAO, ESLBO, ESLCO, ESLDO, ESLEO. It takes 7 weeks to finish each level. Learning contents include Listening, Speaking, Reading, and Writing.

Credit Transfer

For credit transfers, the school will evaluate courses taken in the home countries of our international students. The school will compare the completed courses with Canadian courses and evaluate the number of equivalent credits for which the student can be granted. 
